MOGSouth/MOG 31 Update

Plans are coming together for those MOGSouth members who are planning to attend MOG 31 in Staunton, Virginia and travel to the meet via the Blue Ridge Parkway.

We are planning to rendezvous in Boone, North Carolina on Wednesday evening, June 27. The Best Western Blue Ridge Plaza is holding a block of rooms until May 31 under MOGSouth for the night of Wednesday, June 27. The room rate is \$62.55 plus tax for up to four in a room and includes a Continental breakfast the next morning. The motel is approximately 5 miles from the Parkway. The phone number for reservations is 888 573-0408 and mention MOGSouth.

The rendezvous point for Thursday night, June 28 is the Colony House Motor Lodge in Roanoke, Virginia, approximately 2 miles from the Parkway. They are holding a block of rooms under MOGSouth again until

May 31. The room rate is \$61.00 plus tax and again includes a Continental breakfast the next morning. The phone number for reservations is 540 345-0411 and again mention MOGSouth.

We can make our dinner plans for those nights when we arrive but I understand there are several restaurants nearby each motel.

On Friday morning, June 29, we will motor on to Staunton, Virginia, site of MOG 31, with plans to arrive that afternoon. This is approximately 140 miles from Roanoke via the Parkway

We have decided not to make any formal plans for the return trip home as most return schedules figure to be different. As the MOG 31 banquet is scheduled for Monday night, July 2, Dale and I will most likely dead-head home to Atlanta on Tuesday, July 3, towing the Morgan with her Explorer.

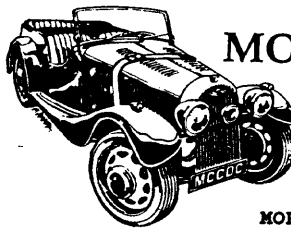
